No.	Item	Description
1	MicroSD Card Slot	Insert or remove microSD card.
2	Front Camera	Adjustable front camera viewing angle.
3	Mic Hole	The mic hole can record sound, which can be turned on or off in the setting menu.
4	Reset Button	Press and hold within reset hole to restart the R10-SPL.
5	Power Button	Long press to power ON/OFF. Short press to turn on/off the screen.



🛕 IMPORTANT 🛕

When the R10-SPL main unit is in sleep mode, pressing the power button will not turn it off. To power off the unit, you must press and hold the power button for 3 seconds.


Wiring Diagram

Yellow - Constant 12V+ source

Red - Ignition controlled ACC source

Black - Ground (-) Polarity (Connect to car chassis or ground point)

Green - Reverse Trigger (+) (Connect to reverse wire)






- Most vehicles have the mirror mounted directly onto the glass, therefore improper tools or techniques used in the installation could result in a damaged or broken windshield. Rydeen is not responsible for damages to windshield caused by installation processes.

5. Universal Mount Solution

Step 1

Install 2pcs clip-on mounting on the back of mirror. Paste the adhesive provided in the position as shown in the picture below, this will prevent vibration and protect the original rear-view mirror from being scratched. Use the provided rubber bands and loop them around the original mirror and tighten down the bands.






Step 2

Connect each unit according to the wiring diagram (page 7).


Route the wires along the interior trim panel and go down the A-pillar. Use a pry tool (not included) to tuck the wires within the panels. Make your ACC, +12V, GND and Reverse Trigger connections.

Follow the wiring diagram, install the backup camera and other accessories.




Inside View

Step 3 Turn the vehicle on and verify that all the functions are working properly.

6. Mirror Replacement Methods

1) Remove the existing mirror and unplug the connector, if one exists. (Note: All vehicles use different mounting solutions. If necessary, consult your local automotive dealer or installation professional for specific instructions.)






Note: If your vehicle uses a universal D-Tab mount, do not remove the D-Tab and use the VSM-AV mount provided.

2) Insert R10-SPL Mirror Back Plate for windshield mount onto the back side of the R10-SPL mirror, using provided screws.



Screw Size: PM2x6mm

3) Attach VSM-AV mount onto the R10-SPL Back Plate using provided screws and Allen key.



- 4) Reattach the R10-SPL mirror by sliding the VSM-AV mount onto the factory windshield tab.
- 5) Adjust to the suitable angle to the mirror, then proceed to Step 2 and Step 3 on page 9-10.


7. Removable Mount Structure



Original Vehicle Mirror Stems




VSM-UNI2 assembly instructions


1) Place the universal mount over the backpack, insert diagonally and slide to the side.




2) Push the universal mount towards to the edge.



3) Align the universal mount holes with the backpack holes and push in.



4) Install provided screws into 4 holes.





Resolution-Select video output resolution, there are two options (1080P / 720P).



Video Record Length-Select the recording time for videos, including three options (1 min, 2 min, 3 min).



Sound Record-Turn on/off audio while recording.

Volume Settings-Adjust system volumes.



Display Date/Time—Date and time information will be always displayed on the right side if select "On", if select "Off", date and time information will be hidden automatically after 5 seconds.

Time Format – Two options for time format, 12 H or 24 H.




Date/Time Settings—Manually set the date and time in the menu or have them automatically adjusted via GPS.



 $Time\ Zone\ Settings-The\ time\ is\ determined\ by\ the\ GPS\ unit.\ Select\ the\ appropriate\ time\ zone\ for\ your\ location,\ with\ options\ for\ six\ time\ zones.$






DST-Turn on/off the Daylight-Saying Time.

G-Sensor Parking Mode—Select the sensitivity of the G-sensor when mirror is in parking monitoring mode, the higher the selection, the higher the sensitivity of the G-sensor. Selecting "Off" will disable the G-sensor during parking mode.



G-Sensor Driving Mode–Select the sensitivity of the G-sensor when mirror is under normal operation, the higher the selection, the higher the sensitivity of the G-sensor. Selecting "Off" will disable the G-sensor during driving.



Rear Mirror image—Control mirror image displayed on the backup camera.

Parking Line Calibration—Select this function to adjust the parking line.




Parking Line Display-Turn on/off Parking Line, default setting is on.

Screensaver–Display will turn off automatically after selected time has been reached with no usage. Selecting "Off" will keep display on during vehicle operation.



Speed Unit — Choose the speed unit of GPS, the default setting is MPH. When using optional GPS unit (sold separately)




Startup Display-Select the camera display mode for start-up.



GPS Information–Find the real-time GPS tracking information. When using optional GPS unit (sold separately)



Language–Select the system language, there are four languages (English, French, Spanish, and Japanese).



Format microSD Card-Delete all files in microSD card.




Factory Reset-Select this function to reset all settings back to default.



Firmware Version-Shows current software version installed in your device.

8.3.3 Replay Video and View Photo Icon



Touch the icon to enter the files for the front and backup camera recordings and view the snapshots. Recordings and images only viewable when system is not recording, to delete press the in icon when in full image.

8.3.4 Video Recording Icon



The R10-SPL records at startup (default). When the system is recording the normal files, the red dot will appear on the top left corner of the screen, when the system is recording SOS files, red dot will turn yellow. To enter the settings menu, you must stop recording. To stop/start recording, simply press on the icon.

Note: R10-SPL Maximum microSD card size is 256GB and Minimum storage required is 16GB. For new microSD card, it takes time for formatting and pre-allocating, bigger memory space takes longer.

8.3.5 Photo Icon

Select the photo icon to take a snapshot. Images will be saved in ".ipeg" format inside the picture folder.

8.3.6 Sound Recording Icon



Turn on/off the sound recording of videos.

8.3.7 File Lock Icon

While recording, press this icon to record a SOS file.

8.3.8 Real-time Speed Information

The real-time speed information is displayed on the left side of mirror when connected to GPS.

10. Troubleshooting

- No display: Check to ensure the screen cable is properly connected and terminal connection is not loose.
- Rydeen logo stuck on screen start-up: Please insert a small pin into the reset hole and restart.
- The image display is hazy or blurry: Check if the lens is dirty.
- GPS suddenly no signal:
 - a. You have entered a tunnel or other area where there is no GPS signal.
 - b. Please check whether the GPS cable is loose or disconnected.
- No video (screen without red dot):
 - a. The microSD card is not formatted or corrupted.
 - b. The microSD card is not inserted in place.
